Honor the first Norwegian immigrants—and someone you know!

On Oct. 9, 1825, the *Restauration* arrived in the United States, carrying the first 53 Norwegians to emigrate to this country. To mark the 200th anniversary of that trip, we're adding a new plaque with the names of 53 Nordic immigrants to Seattle's Leif Erikson Plaza at Shilshole.

Honor an immigrant from Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, or Sweden by submitting their name below. The cost is \$150 per name, even if two names are submitted on one line (i.e., a "Mr. & Mrs." submission is \$300).
